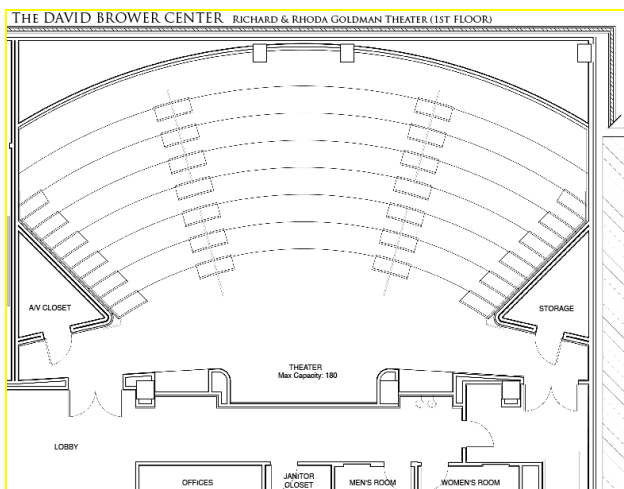

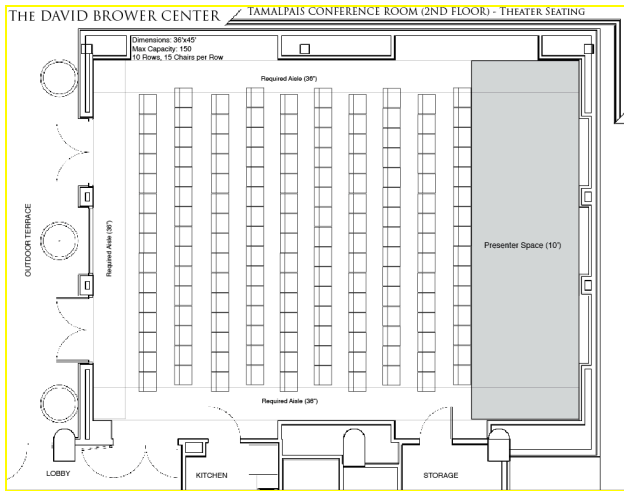


Tamalpais Room

Easily the Brower Center's most versatile space, the large Tamalpais Room is ideal for a variety of special events, meetings, seminars or presentations. 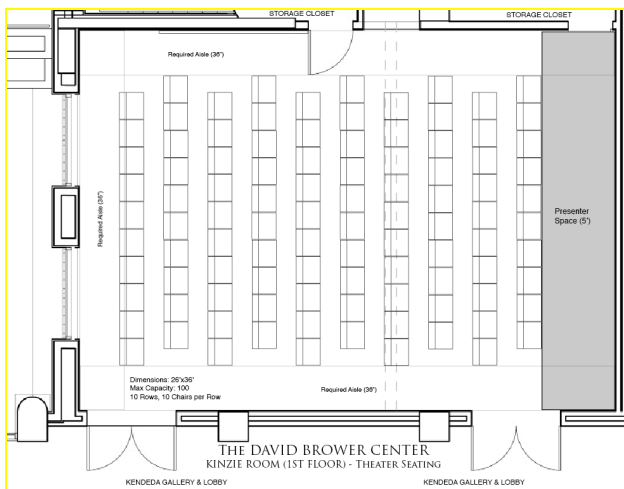


Kinzie Conference Room

This divisible room can be rented as a whole or divided into two individual spaces. The Kinzie Room opens directly into the Brower Center’s lobby and the Hazel Wolf Gallery, an impressive pre-function gathering area. This room is best suited for classes, presentations, meetings and screenings, or as a breakout room for the Goldman Theater and Tamalpais Room. The room features tackboard and whiteboard walls, full audio/visual capabilities with hi-definition digital video and sound reinforcement.

Please inquire about special rates for multiple-day rentals and rates for use of multiple spaces.

Rental fee includes set-up service for all Brower Center supplied special equipment (tables chairs, podium, etc). Use of all equipment is included in rental rate, and room set-up can be customized according to each client's needs.

Audio Visual Service

The Brower Center is proud to feature state of the art audio/visual capabilities throughout its facility. Use of all audio/visual equipment is included in the rental rate. Events utilizing audio/visual equipment do require an A/V technician under the following schedule:

- Tamalpais and Kinzie Room:
 - Audio Only Set-up - \$50 per room (Does not include operator)
 - Audio and Video Set-Up - \$75 per room (Does not include operator)
- Goldman Theater: \$25/hr (4 Hour Minimum) - The technician will customize and operate all audio/visual and theatrical lighting equipment to ensure that your event runs smoothly and professionally. Requires 1 Hour for Set-Up and Breakdown.
- Additional audio/visual assistance during rentals is available for \$25/hour.

Security Personnel

All evening and weekend events require a minimum of one security guard during the entire rental. Additional security guards (up to three total) may be required for events in excess of 180 people according to the following schedule:

Less than 200 guests - 1 Guard

200-300 guests - 2 Guards

More than 300 guests - 3 Guards

Supplemental guards will be scheduled 30 minutes prior to guest arrival, for the duration of the event. Guards are billed at \$35/hr per guard.

Food and Beverage Service

The Brower Center is proud to feature Back to Earth Organic Catering as its preferred caterer. Outside caterers may be considered for evening events, but must be pre-approved and comply with Vendor Policy & Procedures.

Alcoholic beverages are permitted at events with prior approval. All alcoholic beverages must be served by a licensed beverage service provider under a separate contract with the renter.

Transit and Parking Information

The Brower Center is just one block from BART. Take the Richmond-bound train to the Downtown Berkeley station. Walk one block south on Shattuck to Allston Way. Cross Shattuck and walk one block east on Allston. The Brower Center will be on your right before you reach Oxford.

Garage Parking - There are many garages near the Brower Center, including one just below the Center.

- Oxford Garage, 2161 Kittredge St. (One block south of the Brower Center between Shattuck and Oxford St.)
- Allston Way Garage, 2061 Allston Way (Two blocks west of the Brower Center, between Shattuck and Milvia St.)

Pre-Purchased Spaces - The Allston Way Garage offers pre-purchase of 50 to 200 parking spaces. Spaces are subject to availability and may be limited based on date and time of day. Please contact the garage directly (510-981-9443) for arrangements.

Street Parking - Street parking is available on all streets surrounding the Brower Center. Streets are metered until 6 p.m. daily. Sundays are free.
